



Scholarship Program

In an effort to promote and support the turfgrass industry, TurfLinks, Inc. and TurfLinks Environmental Service, Inc. will award two scholarships annually, each in the amount of \$2,500.

These scholarships will be awarded to outstanding students planning a career in turfgrass management.

Each applicant must be a full time student attending an accredited institution of higher learning and must be enrolled in a turf management or related program.

The applicant must be planning to pursue a career as golf course superintendent, sports turf manager, educator, or extension specialist within the turfgrass industry.

All applicants must have at least two seasons of work related experience within the turfgrass industry and be sponsored by a client of either TurfLinks, Inc. or TurfLinks Environmental Service, Inc.

Applicants must have completed at least two semesters in a turfgrass management program and must maintain a 3.0 GPA or better.

Applicants will be evaluated based on *academic achievement, employment history, extracurricular activities, and leadership potential* within the industry. Financial need will not be a factor in the selection process.

Applications will be reviewed by the TurfLinks Scholarship Committee and all decisions will be final. Previous recipients of this scholarship are not eligible and may not reapply.

All applications submitted must be **POSTMARKED** by December 1st and scholarships will be awarded each January.

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How to apply for this scholarship?

(A.) Each applicant must submit the following:

1. Transcripts from all universities and post-secondary schools attended.
2. Letter of recommendation from sponsor (must be client of either TurfLinks, Inc. or TurfLinks Environmental Service, Inc.).
3. Letter of recommendation from academic advisor.
4. Letter of recommendation from instructor.

(B.) Each applicant must complete the following:

1. Complete the attached application.
2. Provide a brief overview of work history within the turfgrass industry.
3. Describe school activities that you participate in (athletics, clubs, etc.) and list any academic distinctions or honors you have received.
4. Describe extracurricular activities that you participate in (including clubs, organizations, community service, etc.).
5. Describe your planned career path within the turfgrass industry.
6. List any industry related associations in which you are a member of.
7. Describe yourself, including strengths and weaknesses.
8. Complete the following essay.

Question: What do you see as the greatest threat to the turfgrass industry in the foreseeable future?

Essay must 1,500 words or less, typed, double spaced, in English.
